Perseverance: steadfastness in doing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success.



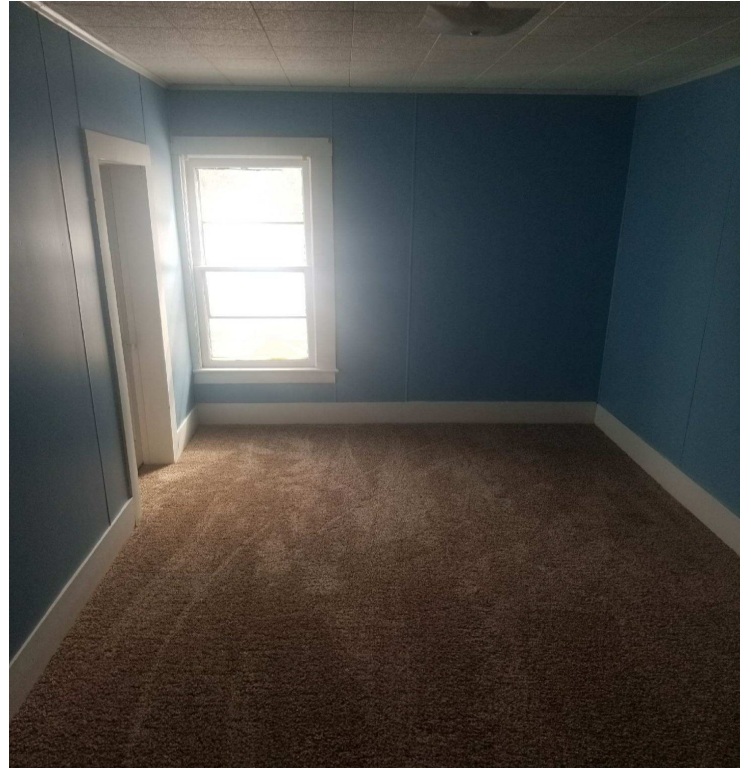

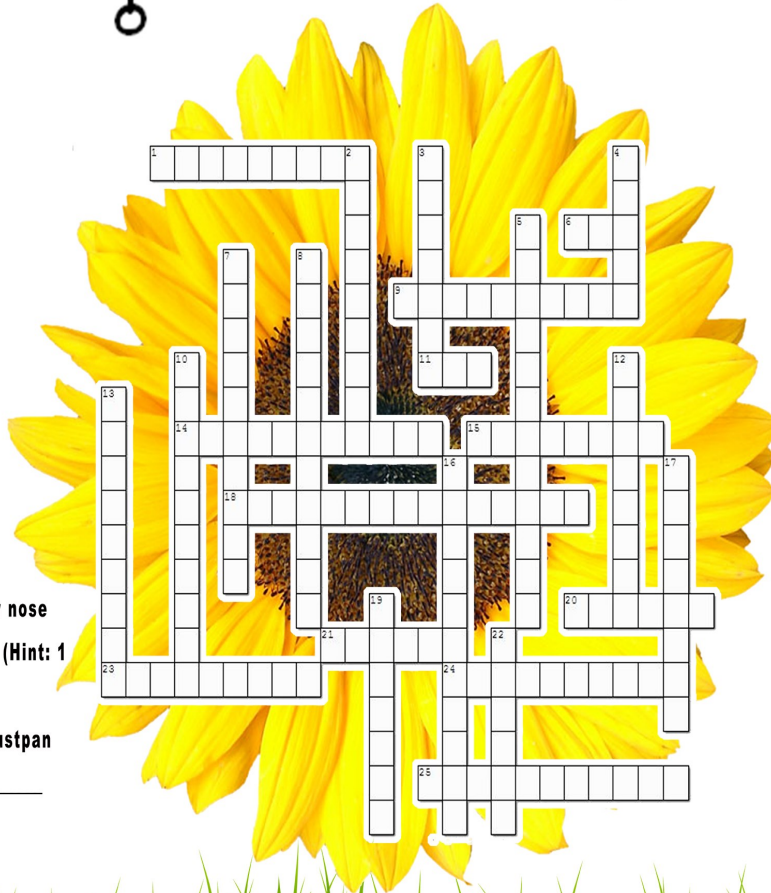
